Paul Herard Brut Rose N.V. <i>Delicious, salmon pink full bodied wine, dry with a well fruited bouquet</i>	£38.50
Laurent Perrier Rose <i>Pale salmon colour, clean and fresh with a hint of wild strawberries, persistent bubbles tasting like caramelised berries with a defined tartness. Dry palate with ripe apple and fresh strawberry tones - fabulous!</i>	£79.60

white wines:

Avanti Chenin Torrontes – Argentina £12.95
Fresh and ripe flavours of peach and lemon, floral notes on the nose.

Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc – Chile £13.95
The nose is full of clean and green youthful sauvignon fruit. Clean and soft on the palate, where pear flavours emerge. Great length, very appealing style.

Rocheburg Chenin Blanc – South Africa £14.25
Refreshing, zesty, unoaked Chenin Blanc, packed full of fresh tropical fruit flavours of pineapple, peach and apple. Very versatile wine.

Pinot Grigio – La Casada – Veneto, Italy £15.25
Bright, refreshing pinot grigio from the Veneto, with delicate aromatics and much more weight and character than you would normally get at this price level

Viognier Vin de Pays d’Oc Domaine Rothschild – S.W. France £15.95
Attractive and aromatic. Medium-bodied with soft flavours of apricot, peach blossom and vanilla. A wine of lovely honeyed richness.

Brown Brothers Everton White – Victoria, Australia £16.95
Sassy, unwooded, dry white. Delicate aromas of peach, apricot and almonds. On the palate – fresh, crisp and lively with attractive fruit flavours.

Cousino Macul Sauvignon Gris – Chile £17.25
The combination of fruitiness and silky texture makes this a fine all rounder

Neethlingshof Gewurtztraminer – Stellenbosch, South Africa £17.50
To many, the epitome of Stellenbosch is a glass of highly scented, spicy, bone dry, white gewurtztraminer from South Africa

Mapa Chardonnay, Baron Rothschild – Chile £18.95
Rich, buttery nose of tropical chardonnay fruit and a hint of roasted hazelnuts. The palate is soft, weighty, nutty, buttery and spicy. Very clean finish.

Mudhouse Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand £19.95
A dry crisp wine with typical Marlborough flavours of guava, currants, minerals, lime and passion fruit. Rich in flavour, the mouth watering acidity leads to a long and lingering finish

Chablis A.C. Le Manoir – France £22.00
Dry and Crisp with pure citrus and green apple fruit – clean and refreshing

Lots of jammy, red berry fruit. An increasingly recognisable and popular grape variety

Malbec Rose, Avanti – Argentina £13.75

Pinotage Rose Steenbok – South Africa £15.20
Delivers abundant and distinctive flavours of fresh strawberries and ripe cherries. Enjoy with seafood or light meat dishes
